## What's expected of members:

- While attendance is not mandatory, we encourage members to attend as many rehearsals and performances as possible, promptly and on time
- Provide marching shoes (**solid black**, no tennis shoes)
- Provide 'Summer Uniform' items (*black means black*)
  - Black Dickies® brand plain front shorts – just above the knee
  - Black belt and black 'no-show' socks
  - Except color guard – see staff for details
- Brass players – provide your own mouthpiece
- Proper maintenance of uniform/instrument/equipment
  - Zips Dry Cleaners will clean any garment for \$3.29; locations in East York and elsewhere ([www.321zips.com](http://www.321zips.com) for locations)
- Know and memorize music &/or routines for proficient performance
- Be responsible and courteous
- Communicate with management & staff
  - Prompt replies to email requests
  - Participation in surveys
